QUALIFICATIONS & REQUIREMENTS

We do not have a minimum GPA requirement for admission, neither compulsory language requirements for exchange students.

International students must hold a visa type VITEM IV (student visa). For information regarding the required documents, visit the website of the Brazilian Diplomatic Office in your home country.

Health insurance is mandatory, but the student can decide the best insurance type for them.

AVERAGE COURSELOAD

The courseload depends on the student's chosen program, as well as on the number of subjects/courses the student might take. We recommend the enrollment in around 4 to 5 courses per semester.


GRADING SYSTEM

The grading system at PUC Minas goes from zero to 100 points. In order to succeed on a course, the student must reach at least 60 points.
