## Documents required in the IRC system

- Application Form;
- Learning Agreement (signed by the Home and Host university);
- Transcript of Records (stamped by the home university);
- Copy of passport or national ID;
- Copy of Certificate of Language Competence (English B2)\*
- Copy of Health Insurance is compulsory (can be delivered after deadline);
- \*level B2 (the sending University decides which certificate is required);

Courses can also be added through the "Changes to LA" process. However, the Physical Education (PE) class must be included in the initial LA and cannot be added later through Changes to LA.

### Accommodation

#### How to apply

Students must apply for a dormitory through the IRC system. Rooms, which accommodate 2 or 3 people, are assigned randomly. The cost is approximately PLN 600 per month, plus water and electricity bills, and a one-time deposit of PLN 400. 
