






Department of Accessibility and Support for People with Disabilities (PRO / DDO)

Health

NFZ- Polish Health Insurance (National Health Fund)

- costs ca. 55,80 PLN/month
- insurance amount of > EUR 30,000 must be valid for the period of the intended stay of the foreigner on the territory of free medical care on the same rights as the Republic of Poland, **Polish citizens**
- **Obligatory** health insurance & additional care
 - Make sure you are insured for the whole period of you study at Wrocław Tech

EHIC Card

- EU student should have obtained it prior to arrival
- it can be used to cover most of the necessary medical treatment
- entitles the holder to state-provided medical treatment as received by a person covered by the country's 'insured' medical scheme

- For the application procedure you need: an application form and ZUS ZZA form (provided by NFZ Insurance Department) if you need help in filling in the forms contact: studentsupport@pwr.edu.pl
- passport / Identity Card
- a confirmation from Wrocław Tech that you are a student


English speaking doctors



Travel medical insurance

cover all expenses that may occur during the stay in Poland due to the necessity of return travel for medical reasons, the need for urgent medical assistance, emergency hospital treatment or death, in which the insurer undertakes to cover the costs of healthcare services provided to the insured directly to the entity providing such benefits, on the basis of a bill issued by this entity.







Residence registration \rightarrow PESEL number \rightarrow Legislation of your stay in Poland

If your stay in Poland lasts longer than 30 days (for non-EU citizens) or 3 months (for EU/EEA citizens) you are obliged to register your residence.

Zameldowanie na pobyt czasowy – Temporary Residence Registration By registering you will automatically receive a PESEL number!

Additionally, EU citizens who stay on the territory of the Republic of Poland for longer than 3 months are obliged to register their stay. Where? Department of Civil Affairs and Foreigners. Check QR code for more info

Legal stay for non-EU students means: possessing a valid visa, residence permit In case your visa or resident permit expires earlier than the end of your study you need to apply for a Temporary Residence Permit due. Where? Department of Civil Affairs and Foreigners. Check QR code for more info

RECOGNITION OF SECONDARY SCHOOL CERTIFICATES full time 1st level students (non-EU)

- **Deadline?** Until the end of the first semester of study. Note! Process is free of charge
- **Exceptions?** Holders of secondary school certificates from: EU, EEA or OECD member states, Ukraine, Belarus, Turkey, China and more.
- Where? Department of Education in Wrocław (Kuratorium Oświaty). Final document to be submitted to the Dean's Office.






How to open a bank account

- Inquire at a given bank (call the helpline) what documents are required before you visit the bank
- In most cases the required documents are: passport with visa (or resident card) and PESEL* number
- Most banks offer English interface and really good mobile applications
- Most banks have good offers for students compare a few of them

beware!

- never give your PESEL number and other personal data to unauthorised people
- a bank will never text you and ask about your data
- protect your mobile device with a password
- bank's website address will always start with https://
- if you lose a credit/debit card remember to block it
- if you lose your passport inform the bank



*PESEL numer is a national identification number used in Poland. You obtain it automatically after you register your address in a proper District Office.




